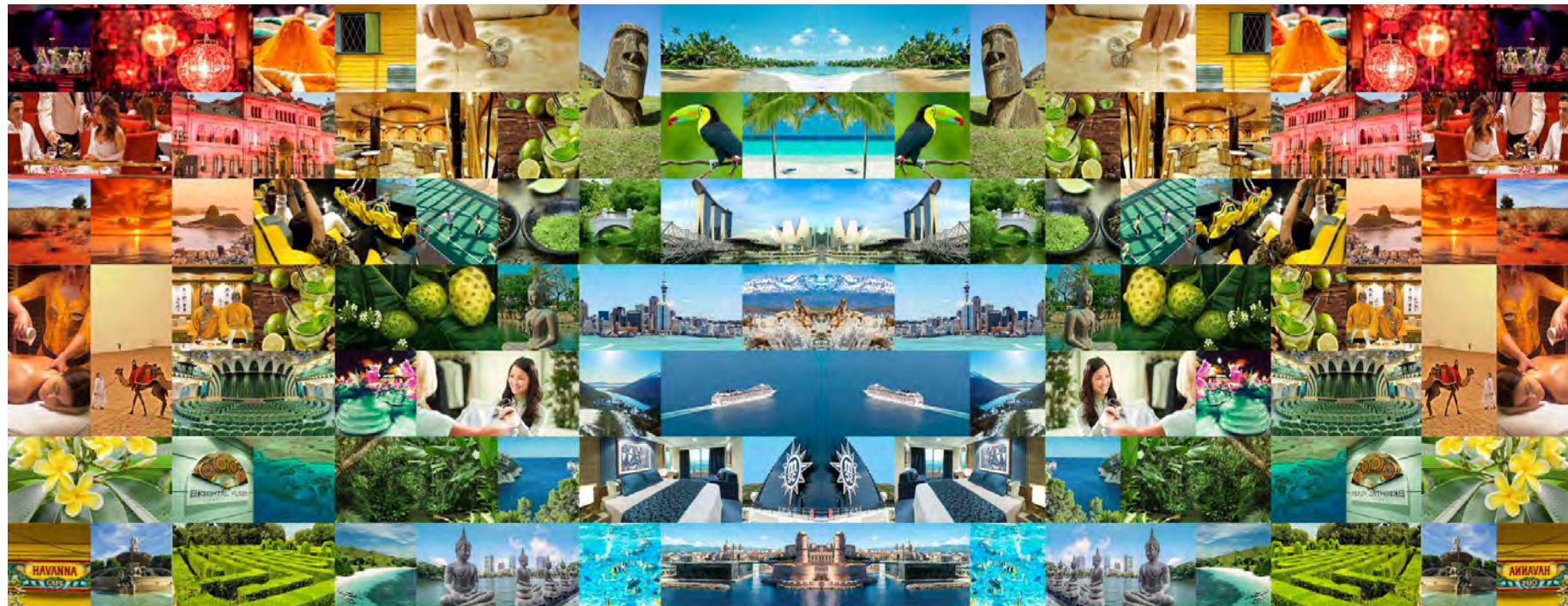

1. FUNCHAL/MADEIRA IS., PORTUGAL FUN18 - CABO GIRAO & RIBEIRA BRAVA - Duration: approx. 4 hours



After first heading to the Pico da Torre vantage point for the panoramic view, the excursion then continues up to Cabo Girão, which is the world's second-highest cliff face. The outlook from the safety railings is out of this world and a great place from which to take photos, but is equally lovely from a little way back. The final leg on the tour begins with a 1-hour drive to Ribeira Brava. Situated on the southwest of Madeira, the pretty, little town is a hive of street cafés and shops. It is believed the town's name derived from the wild (Brava) river (Ribeira) that once flowed through the area. Your tour concludes with your return to Funchal and the ship. *Please note: comfortable shoes and a coat recommended. Guests using a wheelchair are advised that they must be accompanied by a paying helper to provide assistance with getting on and off the coach and that wheelchairs must be collapsible/foldable since the coach has neither a ramp nor a lift. Guests using a wheelchair who would like to participate in this tour are requested to contact the Shore Excursions' Desk promptly once they are on board so that arrangements can be made.*

2. SALVADOR, BRAZIL SAL04 – HISTORICAL SALVADOR - Duration: 4 hours

This excursion will take you through the most interesting historic and cultural places of Salvador. Departing from the port in a motor coach we will make a stop at “Farol da Barra”, the first military construction of Salvador and known as the city's postal card. It includes a walking tour through the historic part of the city, starting with the “Praça da Se” and the “Municipal Square” overlooking the “Todos os Santos bay”. The tour also includes an inside view of the “Igreja da Ordem Terceira de São Francisco”, built in the XVII century and with a marvelous stone façade recalling the Spanish baroque style and one of the most important churches in Bahia state. We will continue the walking tour until reaching Jorge Amado Foundation for an outside visit. After the Pelourinho the tour will proceed to the lower part of town to visit the “Mercado Modelo” the famous handcraft shop before returning to the pier. *Please note: We advise guests to wear hats and comfortable shoes. This tour includes walking on uneven path and cobble stones. This tour is not suitable for guests with physical challenges, wheelchairs and baby strollers. The itinerary and venues visited in this excursion may be altered in calls during the Brazilian Carnival period, please consult the Shore Excursion office once on board. On Sundays Mercado Modelo close at 13h00. This excursion will not be cancelled due to weather conditions (rain).*

3. RIO DE JANEIRO, BRAZIL RIO02T – SUGAR LOAF - Duration: 4 hours

Before the visit of Sugar Loaf, you will have a panoramic tour of the historical center of Rio, with the stop at San Sebastian Cathedral. The excursion includes a photo stop in front of the biggest stadium in the world “Maracanã” and at the famous “Sambodromo”, the temple of the Carnival Samba. With the cable car you will reach the top of the Sugar Loaf hill, one of the most famous symbols of Rio. From the top amazing views of Guanabara Bay, Niteroi and even the famous statue of the Christ. Please note: This excursion will visit a catholic church, therefore knees and shoulders must be covered to enter the church. Itinerary order may change due to lines in the Sugar Loaf. This excursion will not be cancelled due to weather conditions (rain). This excursion will not be cancelled due to weather conditions (rain). The itinerary and venues visited in this excursion may be altered in calls during the Brazilian Carnival period. The passing by of the beaches in Rio de Janeiro are subject to local parades during the year where avenues by the ocean may be blocked for traffic. The Sambodromo complex is under construction and photo stops at the Sambodromo is subject to traffic conditions. This excursion is only available for guests in transit. 4. BUENOS AIRES, ARGENTINA BUE02T - CITY TOUR “BUENOS AIRES & IT’S ENCHANTMENTS” - Duration: 3 hours

Discover the beauty of Buenos Aires one of the most cosmopolitan cities of the South America. The tour will start with a panoramic drive along downtown main avenues, and then you will continue through the city residential neighborhood and its extensive parkland. We will pass by “Recoleta”, an exclusive neighborhood, with its elegant restaurants, sidewalk cafés. Then, continue to “9 de Julio” Avenue, the world’s widest avenue; pass by the “Teatro Colon” and the “Obelisco”, the city’s landmark. The first stop will be at “Plaza de Mayo” lined by the “Casa Rosada” (Government House), the Metropolitan Cathedral and the historic “Cabildo”, which was the Town Hall in colonial times. Proceed to “La Boca”, a colorful portside area where the first Italian immigrants settled in 1751. Depending on traffic there will be a possibility to walk along the famous “Caminito” street. Your excursion will finish with a panoramic drive through one of the most modern neighborhood of Buenos Aires, “Puerto Madero”, where the old docks and warehouses have been turned into restaurants, bars, offices and movie theatres. Please note: This tour is available for guests in transit only. The order of the tour may vary accordingly to traffic. For overnight calls, this excursion will be offered on the first day of the call upon the ships arrival. This excursion can be bought in conjunction with any evening Tango show. Excursion available on the first day.

5. PUERTO MONTT, CHILE - PM01 CITY TOUR PUERTO MONTT & PUERTO VARAS

Your tour begins visiting Angelmó, famous in Chile, because it has many Hand Crafts and Gifts shops, and of course the City Central Market, where we can see how it works one of the principal economic activities, the -shing and sea food, that gets there fresh from the boats to the buyers. Also here we have typical cooking places, basically are restaurants where you can and sea food, -shes and other delicious specialities of the Chilean cuisine. After that the tour continue to the German Monument located in the Main Square, the waterfront pier and the Cathedral, enjoying during the visit the German influence in the architecture of the houses, garden and buildings, and the mix of both cultures. The tour continue to the lovely city of Puerto Varas, also known as “The City of Roses”, with a stop on the lake shore road to appreciate the view of the city from the bay and the “Aurora” sculpture with Llanquihue Lake background. We get to see many of the Attractions of here; the Sacred Heart of Jesus Church built during the year of 1915 to 1918, Baroque Style it’s an exact replica of a church in Black Forest, Germany, from there came some of the first settlers since 1852, The Old Neighbourhood. After that we will go to the downtown by the shore of the beautiful Llanquihue Lake and depending on weather we will see the Osorno Volcano with its ice melting that enhance the water level of the Llanquihue Lake. Finally, drive back to the pier. (The description above may be altered according to the timing chart, but the elements and description of the tour are the same).

6. ARICA, CHILE ARI01 CITY TOUR & ARCHEOLOGY

Your tour begins with a stop at Colon Square located just outside the pier, for a visit of San Marcos Cathedral a 19th-century Gothic edifice designed by Gustave Eiffre and to the colonial age Customs Building. Back on the bus, drive along the sea front Costanera highway, passing the Lisera and El Laucho beaches, continuing into the Azapa Valley. Seen in the distance from the Azapa Valley, do the native aboriginals scratching the salty surface of the brightly colored rocks create several geoglyphs that are the unique drawings of human and animal forms centuries ago. Shortstop near Cerro Sombrero for a closer view and photo opportunity of La Tropicilla geoglyphs. Get back on the bus to drive to the picturesque and complete handicraft village. A reproduction of the Parinacota village (including its nice church) with 12 white workshops where you may find the artisans working on their pottery, carved stones, paintings, looms and where you may find a nice souvenir. Back at the city, the last stop is a visit to the Morro de Arica, a massive promontory towering over the city, where you will enjoy the same panoramic view of the port and city that the Chilean military used to its advantage during the Pacific War by 1880. Finally, drive back to the pier. Optional drop off at the main entrance of the pier where guests will find some handicrafts, souvenirs, etc. (The description above may be altered according to the timing chart, but the elements and description of the tour are the same).

7. CALLAO/LIMA, PERÙ LIM01 LIMA HIGHLIGHTS

Enjoy a panoramic drive through Lima, City of the Kings. Begin the tour by visiting the historic Plaza de Armas, here you will see the Government Palace, City Hall, the Cathedral and the Archbishop's Palace. Continue with a drive through the residential district of Miraflores to take in a magnificent view of the Pacific Ocean. You will make a short stop at the Love Park, inaugurated on February 14, 1993 and intensely visited by couples on Valentine's Day each year. Watch for the Bohemian district of Barranco, the most colorful and artistic neighborhood of Lima, which has numerous bars and restaurants, beautiful colonial houses and postcard looking scenarios. Finally, you will be transferred back to the pier.

8. PAPEETE, TAHITI PPT02 - EAST COAST TAHITI (NO MUSEUM) Duration: approx. 2 hours

The tour will begin by Venus Point, situated in the north on the edge of Matavai Bay; it was a special scene of successive landings of European navigators. James Cook gave the name Venus in memory of his scientific trip to observe the planet. Continue coast drive to Arahoho Blow Hole, a lavatube where waves crash against the rocks, entering an underground channel and creating a powerful sea water geyser that showers on lookers. Weather & time permitting, additional stop can be made at the Faarumai Waterfall. Order of the stops may vary to avoid tourist crowds at the point of interest.

9. AUCKLAND, NEW ZEALAND AKL02- AUCKLAND MUSEUM & CITY SIGHTS - Duration: approx. 4 hours

Celebrate beautiful Auckland on a narrated driving tour highlighting the city sights. Board your motor coach for a short drive to the Auckland Museum. This neo-classically designed building houses exhibits on the New Zealand and the Pacific Islands cultures and showcases an extensive collection of Polynesian artifacts that can be explored independently. Your narrated tour continues as you drive past many of the city's major points of interest. See the downtown area and note the contrasts in architectural style. View the colonial-style shops that line the charming streets of Parnell Village, an exclusive shopping district. Make a roundtrip crossing of the dramatic Harbour Bridge and continue through the city for the completion of your tour and return to port.

10. HOBART/TASMANIA, AUSTRALIA HBA01 HOBART AND RICHMOND -Duration: approx. 3 hours

Hobart is the heart of the island of Tasmania and not only is very picturesque but it also has a rich history dating back before the first fleet sailed into Sydney. On this short tour of Hobart and Richmond guests will see the highlights from the comfort of the motorcoach as well as have some free time to walk the streets of the historic town of Richmond.

11. DARWIN, AUSTRALIA DRW01 TRANSFER TO THE CROCODILE PARK OF THE NORTHERN TERRITORY- Duration: approx. 2.5 hours

Come face to face with Australia's dinosaurs on this amazing crocodile experience. Guests will be transported into the heart of Darwin city to visit what is like a series of fish tanks for Crocodiles, allowing visitors to come face to face with this fierce creatures. At the conclusion on this visit guests will have time to browse the Crocodile gift shop before either returning to the ship by coach or by the shuttle service later in the day.

12. BENOA, BALI BOA04 – LOVELY UBUD - Duration: approx. 5 hours



Take yourself off on an unhurried tour of discovery to one of Bali's loveliest locations, the town and cultural centre of Ubud. You'll first board a coach at the Benoa Cruise Terminal, after which you can look forward to watching the world go by on the roughly 1-hour drive through the most spectacular scenery. Terraced paddy fields and lush vegetation in every hue of green imaginable surround the town, which is particularly noted for its many and varied arts and crafts stores. The friendly on-board tour guide will also provide you with information on the best places to visit in town, so when you arrive at the parking area at the Monkey Forest, you can get your bearings straight away. From viewing ancient temples and checking out the eponymic inhabitants of the Monkey Forest to browsing through the shops and haggling with stallholders at the market, you'll find there's plenty to keep you occupied and amply entertained. You'll then have another chance to enjoy the gorgeous greenery during the return drive to the cruise terminal and your ship.

13. PORT KLANG/KUALA LUMPUR, MALAYSIA PKG11 HIGHLIGHTS OF KUALA LUMPUR (L) - Duration: approx. 7 hours

Batu Caves is a limestone outcrop located just north of Kuala Lumpur with three main caves featuring temples and Hindu shrines. It attracts thousands of worshippers and tourists, especially during the annual Hindu Festival, Thaipusam. Its main attraction is the large statue of the Hindu God “Murugan” at the entrance, besides a steep 272 climb up its steps to finally view the stunning skyline of the city centre. Our next visit will be at the National Monument. This huge bronze monument was built to pay tribute to the valiant soldiers who gave their lives during the Communist Insurgency in the 1950s. Felix De Weldon, the architect of the famous Iwo Jima Memorial, designed it. After lunch at a leading, local restaurant, the next stop will be a photo opportunity at the tallest twin towers in the world: the Petronas Twin Towers are an architectural wonder and the pride of Malaysia. Your tour will conclude with a photo stop at Independence Square, you will see the 328-foot flagpole marking the spot where the Malaysian flag was hoisted on August 31, 1957 to commemorate the country’s independence from British rule.

14. COLOMBO, SRI LANKA CMB01 – COLOMBO HIGHLIGHTS - Duration: approx. 4 hours



Passengers will be picked up from the pier for a city tour of Colombo, a city that like so many in developing countries is fast changing. Almost overnight, skyscrapers arise from where old buildings once stood. Yet in some parts, the old-world charm is retained. For example, there is a 100-year-old clock tower and several British-built, colonial buildings. Other places of interest include the Pettah Bazaar, Hindu and Buddhist temples, residential areas where you’ll see the stately homes of the affluent, the Colombo museum – that we will visit – the Bandaranayake Memorial International Conference Hall (an outright gift to Sri Lanka from the People’s Republic of China), Independence Square, old parliament building, University of Colombo, and Royal College, which is probably the largest school in Asia with 7500 students. Next on the list is a visit to Gangarama Buddhist Temple before having a brief stop for refreshments in a five star Hotel. Please note: Modest attire is required to visit the sacred sites. Shorts and short skirts are not allowed. Ladies should have their shoulders covered. Shoes and hats should be removed prior to entering the temples. Security is very strict, and no bags of any sort may be carried inside. Sunscreen, sunglasses, hats and temple socks are recommended. This tour includes a considerable amount of physical activity such as walking on uneven surface and climbing stairs at the National Museum and at the Temple. It is not recommended for guests with mobility problems or using a wheelchair.

15. MUMBAI/BOMBAY, INDIA BOM03 – MUMBAI: CITY OF CONTRASTS - Duration: approx. 6 hours incl. lunch

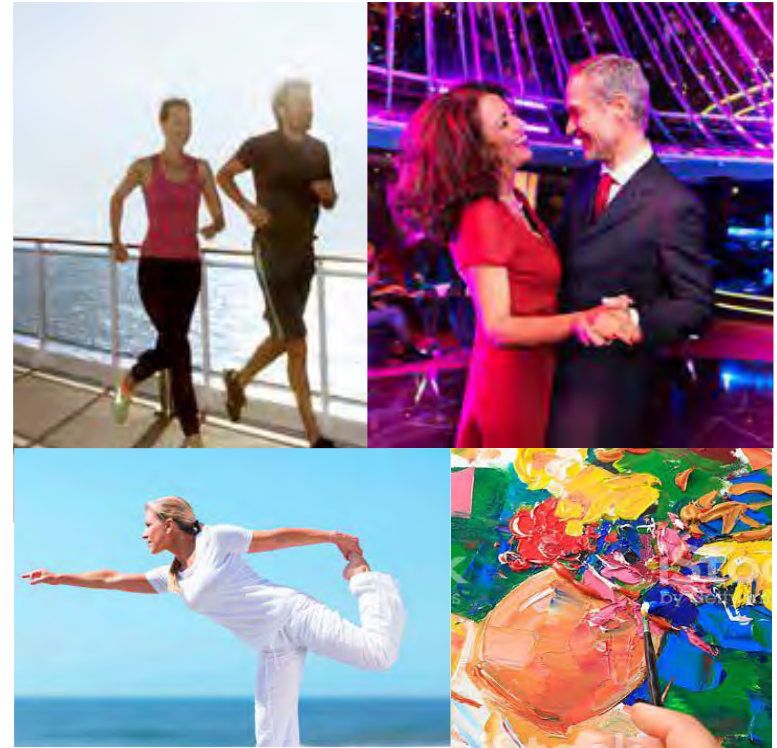


Get set to discover the vibrant city of Mumbai on a fascinating tour that begins with a drive past the magnificent 19th-century Flora Fountain and through the Kala Ghoda neighbourhood to reach your first photo stop, the impressive Gateway of India. The foundation stone of this enormous Indo-Saracenic archway was laid in 1911 to commemorate the visit of King George V and Queen Mary. Next up is a visit to the Prince of Wales Museum to see brightly coloured Buddhist thangka scrolls, Tibetan bronzes and a fabulous collection of more than 2,000 miniatures, after which you’ll drive past the university and high court to reach one of Mumbai’s most iconic buildings: the ISKCON Temple of the International Society for Krishna Consciousness. You will then have an opportunity to stroll among the stalls of Crawford Market before you stop for lunch at the restaurant of a five-star Hotel. The incredible colours and aromas of the Lalbagh Spice Market are yours to enjoy after lunch. Look out for vendors selling everything from aromatic spices such as cardamom, nigella seeds, cumin and chillies, through rustic lanterns and metal trunks to decorated cowbells in a range of sizes. With the heady scent of spices still tingling in your nose, you’ll then be driven back to the pier to rejoin your ship. Please note: The programming and duration of this tour are subject to change to suit local conditions. As the tour also involves some walking and the need to climb a considerable number of stairs to visit the Prince of Wales Museum, it considered suitable only for guests capable of walking a distance of approx. 100 metres.
